Each application for financial assistance will be reviewed on the individual's financial and personal circumstances and assistance awarded accordingly if deemed appropriate by the Management Committee.

Criteria for qualification for financial assistance:

- Working, in receipt of any benefit, and with a family income below the benefits cap (Self Declaration)
- A dependant of someone on benefits
- Unemployed and in receipt of a state benefit
- Young people whose families are eligible for free school meals.
- Receiving Personal Independence Payment
