ACCIDENT GUIDANCE

NON Emergency Procedure:

• Stay calm but act swiftly and observe the situation. Is there danger of further injuries?

- Listen to what the injured person is saying.
- Alert the First Aider who should take appropriate action for minor injuries.
- Deal with the rest of the group and ensure that they are adequately supervised.

• Complete an Accident Report Form & return it to Liselle Carey, Juniors' Administrator.

EMERGENCY Procedure:

• In the event of an injury needing specialist treatment, call the emergency services ("999") Give them the Club/venue details.

- Do not move nor leave alone someone with major injuries. Wait for the emergency medics.
- First Aider:
 - o Check airway and remove mouthguard
 - Check for signs of bleeding and attend.
 - \circ $\,$ Keep the person warm and provide verbal assurance.
 - Check regularly for signs of shock.
- Contact the injured person's parent / guardian via your membership contact list.
- Head injuries:
 - $\circ~$ Remove the player from the field of play as soon as it is medically safe to do so and seek qualified medical attention immediately.
 - $\circ~$ In a tournament ensure that proper medical treatment / advice has been sought before allowing the player to participate further.
- Complete an **Accident Report Form** and return it to Juniors Administrator.
